*Tuition does not include the Tuition Refund Plan (TRP).

Those who pay in full by August 1 may choose not to be covered by the Tuition Refund Plan.

Those who do not pay in full by August must be covered by the Tuition Refund Plan (2.7 % of tuition).

2.7% of \$12,500 = \$12,837.50

2.7% of \$7,500 = \$7,702.50

2.7% of \$12,300 = \$12,632.10

2.7% of \$13,000 = \$13,351.00

Your financial obligation to the school is for the full annual tuition as stated in the enrollment contract. The Tuition Refund Insurance Plan is available to protect your yearly financial obligation in case of early withdrawal. The Tuition Refund Insurance Plan will pay benefits to the school to meet your financial obligation. Remaining benefits not required to meet your obligation to the school will be refunded to you by the school.

A \$1,000 non-refundable deposit is due with the return of the signed contract. The deposit shall be fully credited toward tuition and will be deducted from the last payment.

Before and After School Programs

BEFORE SCHOOL PROGRAM (7:30 - 8:15 a.m.) Tuition: \$4.50/hr.

Children meet on the playground or in the gym. Students are supervised by the Before Care Coordinator.

AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM (3:30 - 6:00 P.m.) Tuition: \$6.00/hr.*

- *Second sibling is 50% of the hourly rate, \$3.00 per hour.
- Additional siblings are free of charge.
- ***\$10.00 a minute after 6:00 p.m.**
Payment must be received before after care resumes.

Financial Aid

- The goal of The St. Michael School is to see that as many students as possible who wish to attend are able to do so. Funds are set aside from the annual budget along with designated gifts to assist in tuition for need.
